On 4 August 1914 Britain declared war on Germany. Thomas enlisted on 10<sup>th</sup> December 1915 he was Private 6429 with the 15<sup>th</sup> Battalion (Labour Company) of the Queen's Royal West Surrey Regiment.

Sadly Thomas died of pneumonia on 4<sup>th</sup> February 1917 and is buried in Horningtoft Church Yard and Commemorated on the Honours Board and a brass memorial plate in the church.






